

Camouflage - to conceal, to cover, to hide

Psalms 91-

Whoever dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty.[a]
2 I will say of the Lord, "He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust."

When we dwell in His presence we rest under His shadow, he is our fortress and protector.

Think of all that you are dealing with right now, many of us are burdened and overwhelmed.

What if there was an answer that would lift your burden and bring you peace, would you want to know what it was? Would you seek it out?

We have the answer: it is in His presence.

Verse 4-He will cover you with his feathers, and under his wings you will find refuge; his faithfulness will be your shield and rampart."

God is our refuge from the storm. He is our protector. Our defender. Life happens and sometimes we face some ugly situations. We get completely devastated. Our hearts are destroyed and we wonder "Why?" We question everything we have ever known. We get mad. Unfortunately we get bitter. God doesn't want us to stay in that place. I can't tell you why we

face grief and loss. I can only tell you that in spite of the earthly pain we experience God is still good.

It is sometimes in the seasons of loss that we grow. We need to draw near to God. The Word clearly states that he keeps us from the snare. The enemy is always seeking to destroy us. Think about Job for a minute and all he endured.

Right now take a moment and get real with God. Express your heart, your pain, let it all out. Then fold it. Now drop it in the bucket. Lift your hands and receive the healing He desires to pour out.

Allow the Lord to cover you . Hide under His shadow. Let His presence consume you.

Vs 5- we don't have to be afraid of the terror by night, nor the arrow that flieth by day.

Vs 6- nor the pestilence that walks in darkness, nor the destruction that wasteth at noonday.

Vs 7- A thousand may fall at your side, ten thousand at your right hand, but it will not come near you.

8 You will only observe with your eyes and see the punishment of the wicked.

What fear paralyzes you?

What Keeps you awake at night?

We don't have to fear the plagues and pest the enemy sets. Destruction can come all around us, but our promise is that it won't destroy us.

Don't allow the enemy to keep you from doing the things you love.

If you say, "The Lord is my refuge," and you make the Most High your dwelling,

10 no harm will overtake you, no disaster will come near your tent.

11 For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways;

12 they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone.

13 You will tread on the lion and the cobra; you will trample the great lion and the serpent.

The Lord is our refuge-: to go to or into a place for shelter or protection from danger or trouble.

It is amazing to know that we have protection from danger and trouble. He is our shelter. So no matter the circumstances or situation we are safe. He even promises that no harm, nothing the enemy meant to destroy us will harm us. He will even watch over our homes. His angels watch over us and guard us.

Reflect for a moment about a scary moment or situation you faced?

Can you look back and see God's protection over your life?

There are probably many moments that we don't even realize that God has been watching over us.

God tells us that we can trample over the enemy. The enemy cannot defeat us. We think the enemy is so big and powerful, but the Word says we can step on the cobras head. When the enemy starts trying to destroy you remember that you are safe in the shelter of the most high.

He camouflages us from the enemy.

- 14 "Because he loves me," says the Lord, "I will rescue him; I will protect him, for he acknowledges my name.
- 15 He will call on me, and I will answer him;I will be with him in trouble,I will deliver him and honor him.
- 16 With long life I will satisfy him and show him my salvation."

Because of our love for the Lord, he promises to rescue and protect us. He will answer us when we call. He doesn't leave us when we are in trouble. The Word promises that He never leaves us or forsakes us.

Remember he is our shelter.
