October is here and it is the changing of the season. The fall of the year people seem to be more oriented. This season also brings a Holiday that is quiet controversial within the church. I am going to share about what the Bible says about fear and torment, also what the Bible says about Faith. My take on what the Bible says on Halloween.

My only purpose is to encourage you and help build your faith. I am not casting judgement or pushing my own personal convictions. I am just following the prompting of the Holy Spirit. I have wrestled with this devotional, but then as I was in the shower, I simply said , “Yes Lord I will obey.”

Fear can be so Overwhelming. Many times we do not realize that as Christian’s we have promises in the Word to apply over these situations, however we can’t use them because we have too many open doors in our lives.

As we go through the scriptures I want you to have an open mind and open heart. Allow the Holy Spirit to speak to you and give guidance and instruction.

Psalms 91 is one of my favorites, it is a reminder that no matter our circumstances or situations, God is our shield, protector and refuge.

So many times we allow ourselves to be crippled with fear. We allow the enemy to rob us of our rest and peace. Stand on these promises and take back your peace.

Psalms 91:4-5 “He will cover you with his opinions, and under his wings you will find refuge; his faithfulness is a shield and buckler. You will not fear the terror of the night, nor the arrow that flies by day.”

I have known what it is to have more month than money, I have known what it is to have a savings account. I have had an abundance and I have had to put meals together with very little. One thing I can say is God was always faithful. I had to learn to trust even in the moments I couldn’t see things working , He was working. I know there were times He had to work things out in me.

Whatever your situation or circumstances, trust that God is working thing’s out for you.

Matthew 10:29-32 Are not two sparrows sold for a penny? And not one of them will fall to the ground apart from your Father. But even the hairs of your head are all numbered. Fear not, therefore; you are of more value than many sparrows. So everyone who acknowledges me before men, I also will acknowledge before my Father who is in heaven.”

Praising through the storm, anxiety and fear is hard for people to understand. Our natural instincts tell us to fret and worry. When we walk in the spirit we have to trust. When God is for us and watching us there is nothing the enemy can do.

Lord I lay these situations down at your feet. They are too overwhelming for me. I need you to come and move mountains for me. Lord I ask for divine intervention in these situations. I declare this in Jesus name.

**Psalms 56:3-4** “When I am afraid, I put my trust in you. In God, whose word I praise, in God I trust; I shall not be afraid. What can flesh do to me?”

**2 Timothy 1:7** “For God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control.”

When you walk in the ways of the Lord, He keeps you from stumbling. When we lay down to rest, we don't have to be tormented. I know we all go through situations and carry burdens many times those rob us of our rest.

God walks with us, He goes before us. We don't have to be afraid to walk in new doors that He opens for us. We can walk confidently in the fact that, He guides our steps. The Lord gives us more than one reminder that we are not walking alone. No matter where we are in life, God is with us. I say this with absolute certainty. I walked in a season of darkness and there were so many moments, that I felt the Holy Spirit tugging at me. I know the prayers that were being prayed for me are the reason why I am alive today.

**Proverbs 3:23-24** “Then you will walk on your way securely, and your foot will not stumble. If you lie down, you will not be afraid; when you lie down, your sleep will be sweet.”

**Deuteronomy 31:6** “Be strong and courageous. Do not fear or be in dread of them, for it is the Lord your God who goes with you. He will not leave you or forsake you.”

**Joshua 1:9** “Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord will be with you wherever you go.”

If you are feeling alone apply these scriptures over your life and situation. Let these words get deep in your spirit. You need to know these are not just words, but they were given to us to help walk our Christian walk. The problem is many times we think we are the ones who have to walk this walk. You can not walk this walk in your own strength. You have to walk this walk holding the hand of the mighty God.

**Lord I ask you to remove every anxiety, every fear, every worry, Lord I lay every spirit of loneliness down at your feet. God I need to remember that I do not need to be afraid. I need you more than I need anything. God thank you for your word and your love. I thank you that you guide my steps and I do not have to walk in fear in Jesus name I am free.**

**Worry is what we do when we just don't know how to make ends meet. We have to trust that God is in control. There have been moments where I just didn't know how I would make it, I have been down to my last five dollars, and sometimes had to choose between feeding my kids or having gas in my car. I would just say God I trust you, and He would make a way. God has blessed me so many times. Yes there were moments, I would cry and beg and just be so overwhelmed. As I have grown in my walk with the Lord, I have learned to trust that He is faithful. I know He is working on my behalf, even when it seems dark. God is still God when I'm hungry, He is good when I have a need that seems impossible. God is good even when I am facing sickness. God is good. I do not have to fear life's situations. I have to trust in the one who makes a way.**

**Psalms 107:28-30 "Then they cried out to the Lord in their trouble, and he brought them out of their distress. He still the storm to a whisper; the waves of the sea were hushed. They were glad when it grew calm, and he guided them to their desired haven."**

**John 14:25-27 "Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid."**

**Genesis 50:21 "So do not fear; I will provide for you and your little ones.' Thus he comforted them and spoke kindly to them."**

**God always provided for my children. God always showed me that He was good. I had to not fear what I could not provide. I had to ask God to take what He placed in my hands and bless it. I am so thankful my children have grown into such giving and loving adults. I am so proud of them. When they were growing up we participated in so many ministries that gave food and did outreach, they learned that we gave even out of our need, They learned first hand how God can provide miraculously.**

**No matter the situation don't take your eyes off of God. When we take our focus off of God and put them on our situation and our lack, we remove our faith and we are walking in fear and He is not able to do what He needs to do.**

**Deuteronomy 3:22 "You shall not fear them, for it is the LORD your God who fights for you."**

God fights for us. He loves us. He is fighting for us even when we do not realize it. The enemy wants to destroy what God has placed inside of you. God has a calling on your life. He has placed gifts inside of you that will change the world. The enemy knows when you begin to realize that Greater is He that is in you, then He that is in the world, his tricks won't work on you. God has something unique that He has called you to do. Do not be afraid of what people will think. Do not allow fear to stop you from walking in the path that God has for you. God will keep you safe and protect you. You need to realize that the enemy is a defeated foe and he is under your feet.

I dare you to proclaim, that you are free from fear. I dare you to speak life over every dark situation in your life. I dare to speak JESUS over your life, your finances, your health, your family, your job, your community.

Proverbs 29:25 "Fear of man will prove to be a snare, but whoever trusts in the Lord is kept safe."

Romans 8:38-39 "And I am convinced that nothing can ever separate us from God's love. Neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither our fears for today nor our worries about tomorrow—not even the powers of hell can separate us from God's love."

It is time to Cast down Fear

Fear has held God's people down too long. We have to let our faith arise. We don't have to fear because God is with us. We need to take our thoughts captive. We need to commit our memory to learning the Word of God. When we begin to have thoughts of anxiety or fear we need to apply the Word of God in every situation.

Faith says I believe you God even when I can't see the other side.

Fear says I can not do this.

Faith says I am going to make it.

Fear says I will lose everything.

Faith says I am going follow God's plan even though people won't understand.

Fear says I am not going to do this because people will talk about you.

Faith brings, joy, hope, peace.

Fear bring torment, anxiety, depression, loneliness.

We have to cast these things down in Jesus name.

Casting down Fear

2 Corinthians 10:5 We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ.

Isaiah 41:8-10 "So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand."

1 John 4:18-19 There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear. For fear has to do with punishment, and whoever fears has not been perfected in love. We love because he first loved us."

Romans 8:37 No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us.

## Reasons why we don't celebrate Halloween

*I am sharing with you my convictions on this subject. I married my husband two years ago and he has three smaller children from a previous marriage. We have had the kids and due to the co-parenting situation, we got them costumes and took them to church festivals. I can no longer do this. It goes against my convictions. Please do not think I am being judgmental at all, I am sharing what the Holy Spirit prompted me to share. You have to pray and decide what is best for you and your family and what your convictions are. All I ask is that you read and this with an open heart.*

**Ephesians 5:7-15** 7 Therefore do not be partners with them. 8 For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Live as children of light 9 (for the fruit of the light consists in all goodness, righteousness and truth) 10 and find out what pleases the Lord. 11 Have nothing to do with the fruitless deeds of darkness, but rather expose them. 12 It is shameful even to mention what the disobedient do in secret. 13 But everything exposed by the light becomes visible—and everything that is illuminated becomes a light. 14 This is why it is said: “Wake up, sleeper, rise from the dead, and Christ will shine on you.” 15 Be very careful, then, how you live—not as unwise but as wise,

Clearly this passage says, we are not to have affiliation with darkness. We cannot participate in things that bring glory to the devil. This goes beyond Halloween.

**Philippians 4:8** Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things.

Does Halloween make you think about the goodness of God? Do you realize that every horror movie has demonic activity attached to it? You are welcoming the dark and demonic in your home when you watch these movies, decorate for this holiday or allow your children to be a part of this day.

We are not to be like the world. We are to be different. We are to be separate. We live in this world but we are not to live like the world. I'm sorry it goes against everything the Word of God teaches. We are to be a light in the darkness, not hide our light. We cannot allow things in our home that goes against the Word of God and expect the blessing of God in our home.

**Deuteronomy 18:9-13** 9 When you enter the land the Lord your God is giving you, do not learn to imitate the detestable ways of the nations there. 10 Let no one be found among you who sacrifices their son or daughter in the fire, who practices divination or sorcery, interprets omens, engages in witchcraft, 11 or casts spells, or who is a medium or spiritist or who consults the dead. 12 Anyone who does these things is detestable to the Lord; because of these same detestable practices the Lord your God will drive out those nations before you. 13 You must be blameless before the Lord your God.

There are so many movies we think are innocent that clearly go against everything in these scriptures. I cannot allow these things in my home. Sometimes people do not understand and that is alright. I just pray God open the eyes of their understanding. I have learned in my life that when you allow a little bit of compromise in your life it grows and the more it grows, it over takes your life. Soon you have no moral compass, you have no problem with sin anymore. This doesn't happen overnight, it is a slow fade.

These scriptures give very clear instructions and insights into what the Lord says to us.

**2 Corinthians 6:17** Therefore, "Come out from them and be separate, says the Lord. Touch no unclean thing, and I will receive you."

**John 3:19-20** 19 This is the verdict: Light has come into the world, but people loved darkness instead of light because their deeds were evil. 20 Everyone who does evil hates the light, and will not come into the light for fear that their deeds will be exposed.

**1 Thessalonians 5:19-22** 19 Do not quench the Spirit. 20 Do not treat prophecies with contempt 21 but test them all; hold on to what is good, 22 reject every kind of evil.

**Ephesians 5:8-17** 8 For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Live as children of light 9 (for the fruit of the light consists in all goodness, righteousness and truth) 10 and find out what pleases the Lord. 11 Have nothing to do with the fruitless deeds of darkness, but rather expose them. 12 It is shameful even to mention what the disobedient do in secret. 13 But everything exposed by the light becomes visible—and everything that is illuminated becomes a light. 14 This is why it is said: "Wake up, sleeper, rise from the dead, and Christ will shine on you." 15 Be very careful, then, how you live—not as unwise but as wise, 16 making the most of every opportunity, because the days are evil. 17 Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the Lord's will is

Here is where I stand, horror movies are not just a good scare, they are an open door to demonic activity. Halloween is a day that evil is allowed to be celebrated. God is not part of that. We are to live our life to please the Lord, We are to bring others to the light and we cannot do that if we are living like they do. I understand people use Trunk or Treat as an outreach and that is their convictions. I do not want to celebrate fear, murder, evil, death, witches and that's what people do on Halloween.

I am not gonna argue with people over this, I have learned that over the years that I need to share my belief and then just agree to disagree. People have to face their convictions in their time. I do not want anything to come between me and Jesus. I do not want to cause any young Christians to stumble because I am too harsh. I share the truth in love. I pray that you sincerely ask the Lord to speak to you about these things.

**Romans 14** Accept the one whose faith is weak, without quarreling over disputable matters. 2 One person's faith allows them to eat anything, but another, whose faith is weak, eats only vegetables. 3 The one who eats everything must not treat with contempt the one who does not, and the one who does not eat everything must not judge the one who does, for God has accepted them. 4 Who are you to judge someone else's servant? To their own master, servants stand or fall. And they will stand, for the Lord is able to make them stand. 5 One person considers one day more sacred than another; another considers every day alike. Each of them should be fully convinced in their own mind. 6 Whoever regards one day as special does so to the Lord. Whoever eats meat does so to the Lord, for they give thanks to God; and whoever abstains does so to the Lord and gives thanks to God. 7 For none of us lives for ourselves alone, and none of us dies for ourselves alone. 8 If we live, we live for the Lord; and if we die, we die for the Lord. So, whether we live or die, we belong to the Lord. 9 For this very reason, Christ died and returned to life so that he might be the Lord of both the dead and the living. 10 You, then, why do you judge your brother or sister? Or why do you treat them with contempt? For we will all stand before God's judgment seat. 11 It is written: "'As surely as I live,' says the Lord, 'every knee will bow before me; every tongue will acknowledge God.'" 12 So then, each of us will give an account of ourselves to God. 13 Therefore let us stop passing judgment on one another. Instead, make up your mind not to put any stumbling block or obstacle in the way of a brother or sister. 14 I am convinced, being fully persuaded in the Lord Jesus, that nothing is unclean in itself. But if anyone regards something as unclean, then for that person it is unclean. 15 If your brother or sister is distressed because of what you eat, you are no longer acting in love. Do not by your eating destroy someone for whom Christ died. 16 Therefore do not let what you know is good be spoken of as evil. 17 For the kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking, but of righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit, 18 because anyone who serves Christ in this way is pleasing to God and receives human approval. 19 Let us therefore make every effort to do what leads to peace and to mutual edification. 20 Do not destroy the work of God for the sake of food. All food is clean, but it is wrong for a person to eat anything that causes someone else to stumble. 21 It is better not to eat meat or drink wine or to do anything else that will cause your brother or sister to fall. 22 So whatever you believe about these things keep between yourself and God. Blessed is the one who does not condemn himself by what he approves. 23 But whoever has doubts is condemned if they eat, because their eating is not from faith; and everything that does not come from faith is sin.

**Love each other, help each other to grow in love. Pray for others that are simply growing in their faith. Remember back to when you were new if your faith and others had to help you along. Do not allow the enemy to hold you back in any area of your life.**



## **Faith triumphs over fear**

**We have talked to much about fear that I want to end this on a good note.**

**When you go before the throne of God, believe that what you are asking for is gonna happen. Does that mean every prayer will be answered the way you think it should be? No, God will answer your prayers the way that is best in that situation.**

**Do not be discouraged when you don't get the answer that you think you are supposed to get this is where the enemy gets in our ear to discourage us. Stand on the promised that God has given us in His Word.**

**Mark 11:24 24 Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours.**

**God gives us strength when we kneel before Him. That is a hard concept for the human mind to understand. We have to humble ourselves and submit to God. When we come before Him with our needs He is able to do more than we can even imagine. We sit here and try to figure it all out, when He simply asks us to trust Him. Read this passage and make it personal as you do your faith will start to build.**

**Ephesians 3:14-21 14 For this reason I kneel before the Father, 15 from whom every family in heaven and on earth derives its name. 16 I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being, 17 so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, 18 may have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, 19 and to know this love that surpasses knowledge—that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God. 20 Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us, 21 to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen.**

**As a believer you will face some tough situations. Faith doesn't say you will have an easy life. Faith says I am going to get through this. Faith says "My God will not fail." Faith is knowing that God will turn things around for you. James 1 tells us that we cannot wavier in our faith. We must hold on to our faith, especially as we grow and mature in our walk with the Lord. We can not doubt. We have to know that God hears us. We cannot let the storms of life shake us. I know that is hard for our human mind to process. We cannot understand how to hold on when life is crumbling. The thing is we are not holding onto our own strength. Read this chapter and make it personal and keep reading it until it becomes alive in your spirit.**

**God is able to do the impossible. God is always at work. Even when you are walking in the valley of the shadow of death He is walking with you. No matter how dark the night. God is there and joy will come in the morning.**

**James 1 2 Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters whenever you face trials of many kinds, 3 because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance. 4 Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything. 5 If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you. 6 But when you ask, you must believe and not doubt, because the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind. 7 That person should not expect to receive anything from the Lord. 8 Such a person is double-minded and unstable in all they do. 9 Believers in humble circumstances ought to take pride in their high position. 10 But the rich should take pride in their humiliation—since they will pass away like a wild flower. 11 For the sun rises with scorching heat and withers the plant; its blossom falls and its beauty is destroyed. In the same way, the rich will fade away even while they go about their business. 12 Blessed is the one who perseveres under trial because, having stood the test, that person will receive the crown of life that the Lord has promised to those who love him.**

**God gives us good gifts. God is not evil and He doesn't tempt us with evil. The temptations we fight are the sins we have not dealt with. There comes a time that we have to draw a line in the sand and say I will not go down that road again. God gave us Jesus so we would not have to pay the price for our sin. His desire isn't for people to perish , God want us to want to love Him.**

**13 When tempted, no one should say, "God is tempting me." For God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does he tempt anyone; 14 but each person is tempted when they are dragged away by their own evil desire and enticed. 15 Then, after desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, gives birth to death. 16 Don't be deceived, my dear brothers and sisters. 17 Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows. 18 He chose to give us birth through the word of truth, that we might be a kind of first-fruits of all he created.**

### **Listening and Doing**

**We have to walk the walk. We cannot simply hear the Word and never act and obey. When we allow our ears and hearts to be open we allow the Word to change us. We need to listen and not just speak to speak. We need to allow the Holy Spirit to guide our speech. I am sorry but it is not alright for believers to use profanity. Once we hear the truth we have to walk in that truth. We have to listen to what the Spirit is saying. I know God is calling His people to a Holy place. There is no more just being comfortable. God is asking us what will we give up in order to walk in the calling He has placed over us. When we seek the face of God we are changed. Were not comfortable just existing. We have an urgency in our spirit to share the love of Jesus with others. Sin is still sin. We cannot rewrite the Bible to keep from offending people. People want to be comfortable with their sin. The Word is very clear that SIN SEPERATES US FROM GOD. So SIN WILL NOT enter into Heaven.**

19 My dear brothers and sisters, take note of this: Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry, 20 because human anger does not produce the righteousness that God desires. 21 Therefore, get rid of all moral filth and the evil that is so prevalent and humbly accept the word planted in you, which can save you. 22 Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says. 23 Anyone who listens to the word but does not do what it says is like someone who looks at his face in a mirror 24 and, after looking at himself, goes away and immediately forgets what he looks like. 25 But whoever looks intently into the perfect law that gives freedom, and continues in it—not forgetting what they have heard, but doing it—they will be blessed in what they do. 26 Those who consider themselves religious and yet do not keep a tight rein on their tongues deceive themselves, and their religion is worthless. 27 Religion that God our Father accepts as pure and faultless is this: to look after orphans and widows in their distress and to keep oneself from being polluted by the world.

Have you seen how tiny a mustard seed is? God said that is all the faith we need. Because when our faith is in God, he moves the mountain. So whatever mountain you are facing just believe that God is moving it out of your life. Nothing is impossible with God. Keep praying and believing until your answer comes.

Be persistent and consistent in your faith. Do not waiver with how you feel emotionally. This faith walk isn't a human feeling, faith walking is believing in what you can not see. Faith is trusting that God is faithful and unmovable. Faith says God will not fail me.

Matthew 17:20 20 He replied, “Because you have so little faith. Truly I tell you, if you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, ‘Move from here to there,’ and it will move. Nothing will be impossible for you.”

I love this chapter. These are some people who went through some tests and did not lose hope. These are people that believed in the promised land. They knew God was true and they believed even though they didn't see the promise of Jesus come to pass.

Hebrews 11 Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see. 2 This is what the ancients were commended for. 3 By faith we understand that the universe was formed at God's command, so that what is seen was not made out of what was visible. 4 By faith Abel brought God a better offering than Cain did. By faith he was commended as righteous, when God spoke well of his offerings. And by faith Abel still speaks, even though he is dead. 5 By faith Enoch was taken from this life, so that he did not experience death: “He could not be found, because God had taken him away.” For before he was taken, he was commended as one who pleased God. 6 And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.

Noah built the ark even when the neighbors made fun of him. Noah trusted in what God said told him to do. Where are my Noah's at? Willing to obey even when its new uncharted, never done before waters. Who is willing to say ok God, I am here, I am not sure what we are doing but I am here. Because he obeyed, his family was saved. Think about that the promise and the blessing extended to his children. How many of this want this for your children?

**7 By faith Noah, when warned about things not yet seen, in holy fear built an ark to save his family. By his faith he condemned the world and became heir of the righteousness that is in keeping with faith.**

**Where are the Abrahams and Sarah's? My seasoned people who think they are too old for God to birth something new in them. If you are breathing God still has a purpose for you. Get ready because some of you are about to birth some Isaacs, there are some children of promise about to come forth from your line. God is calling you to carry them and raise them up. God is calling you to use your wisdom to train a younger generation of believers. Do not sit there idle allow your faith to be renewed and restored.**

**8 By faith Abraham, when called to go to a place he would later receive as his inheritance, obeyed and went, even though he did not know where he was going. 9 By faith he made his home in the promised land like a stranger in a foreign country; he lived in tents, as did Isaac and Jacob, who were heirs with him of the same promise. 10 For he was looking forward to the city with foundations, whose architect and builder is God. 11 And by faith even Sarah, who was past childbearing age, was enabled to bear children because she considered him faithful who had made the promise. 12 And so from this one man, and he as good as dead, came descendants as numerous as the stars in the sky and as countless as the sand on the seashore.**

**All of these knew there was something more to life. They knew there was a promise. They lived their life not losing faith or hope. They knew that they were not meant to be a part of this world but something far greater. We have lost our heavenly focus by being so consumed with worldly desires. Sometimes the promise comes to the next generation. Sometimes we are laying the ground work for the generations to come. Do not lose hope. I know some are in dry seasons. Some of you are so broken you can't even find the words to pray. Hold on to the hope that by Faith we will enter into the promise land. Faith is greater than any fear. Faith is greater than any anxiety. Faith says, "I know God is making a way" Faith says, "He will never leave me or forsake me." Faith says, even though I can not see what God is doing, I know He is working. Faith looks at the impossible and say's, #BUTGOD.**

**13 All these people were still living by faith when they died. They did not receive the things promised; they only saw them and welcomed them from a distance, admitting that they were foreigners and strangers on earth. 14 People who say such things show that they are looking for a country of their own. 15 If they had been thinking of the country they had left, they would have had opportunity to return. 16 Instead, they were longing for a better country—a heavenly one. Therefore God is not ashamed to be called their God, for he has prepared a city for them.**
